

## CALL FOR THE RESEARCH PAPER FOR ORAL OR POSTER PRESENTATION

### Submission Instructions

1. Prepare an abstract of your presentation. The body of the abstract should not be more than 250 words excluding title, name of authors and school. The abstract should provide a summary of the content of your proposed paper. It should follow the following format.

- Title (capitalized)
- Author/s (with superscripts according to institutions if authors come from different institutions) Underline the name of the presenting author.
- Objectives
- Significance
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Use Arial, font size 10

2. Oral presentation must be supported by a PowerPoint (97 or later) presentation. No other form of projection will be available. Powerpoint presentations should be submitted online via e-mail. Please bring a back-up on a CD with you.

3. Submitted papers will be accepted either for oral or poster presentation.

### Review Process

Each paper will be reviewed by three independent reviewers. As part of their evaluation, the reviewers will rate submissions according to their contribution, originality/novelty, technical depth/merit, and quality of presentation.

### Notification to Authors

- Indicate the e-mail address of the presenting author in the footnote.
- Presenting authors will be notified of acceptance by March 30, 2012.
